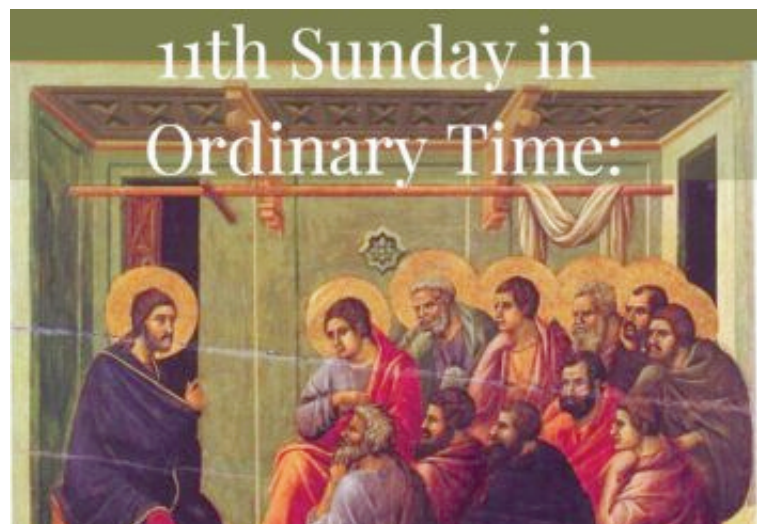

Message from our Pastor June 14 2026

These are the last Academic days of Incarnation Catholic Academy. In just over a week it will be closings its doors as an Academy forever. While this is a sad moment. It is also a moment to give thanks to God for the many blessings the Academy gave all of us. Remember what I said in last week's bulletin, change is hard but change is also a sign that God is with us and God is working.

I would like to take this moment to ask everyone to thank the members of the Academy Board, past and present. They love our youth and they worked very hard to make sure the school has had all it needed to maintain high standards, good grades, and catholic witness and values. I also want to thank, in your name, all the principals of the school, past and present, including the sisters of St Dominic who taught in our school for generations. I want to thank our teachers, aides, and support staff, who give so much of themselves because they love our kids. I want to thank all the parents and families who sacrificed so much so their children had a great catholic school education. Lastly, I want to thank the students and our blessed alumni. This closing has been hardest on them as many current students will be moving on to different catholic and non catholic schools.

You are all being held in the Sacred Heart of Jesus in this month of June, dedicated to the Sacred Heart.. While the school is closing, Catholic education and the work of educating our kids continues. As I said last week, it continues in our even more important religious ed and programs for our youth in the parish. These programs need to be adjusted to fit this new reality and we must now double up our support and our work in these areas. We still must teach our kids. Our parish catholic school education system will continue as we link to St Gregory the Great Academy. The Academy Board has been invited to join their board. The school has matched our tuition, the students on grants will continue to have them, the St Carlo Grant continues, and we will be asked to support our kids in that academy. I and Fr Samuel will be on their Board, and our students in Religious Ed will be invited to discern if they want to go to that Academy. This is similar to what happened when St Gerard closed their school 20 years ago. And while that was sad and hard, it has all worked out as a blessing and grace. God worked with us at that time of change and God is working now! Lastly, even though I will be moving at the end of the month, Bishop Brennan has asked me to stay on as Board Chair. I will be signing all the checks, paying all outstanding bills, organizing classroom items to be moved to St Greg's, and later to Immaculate Conception and the other Deanery Academies. I will be working with Fr Samuel in all this over the summer and fall, so you may see me around Incarnation from time to time. Sandra, Academy Secretary, will be moving over to the parish side of things and will be employed by the parish and she is still a parishioner. Denise, while moving with me to be employed by O.L. Lourdes as Adm Assistant to the pastor and bookkeeper there - currently the parish does not have one - she will still be working with the books of the Academy on quickbooks and of course she is still a active Incarnation-St Gerard parishioner. The cleaning company of the Academy will be working through the summer to assist me in organizing everything and all the records of the academy will either go with each current student or be packed up and sent to the Archives of the Diocese for filing. If you need your record you will have to reach out to them. The building itself will of course still be used by the parish. The community, along with Fr Samuel, the parish trustees, the new parish finance council and new parish pastoral council that he will create, and the diocese real estate office, will have to discern how the building will be used to create funding for the parish.

This will happen eventually in the form of a long term lease, similar to that of St Gerard's rental. This will take time, discernment, patience, and prayer. The ability to rent part or all of the building will help to solve the long term debt problem of the parish for good. If anyone has any questions or concerns on all this please reach out to me now, or when I move down the block to Lourdes.

Mensaje de nuestro párroco, 14 de junio de 2026

Estos son los últimos días de la Academia de la Iglesia de la Encarnación. En poco más de una semana cerrará sus puertas como academia para siempre. Aunque es un momento triste, también es un momento para dar gracias a Dios por las numerosas bendiciones que la academia nos ha brindado a todos. Recuerden lo que dije en el boletín de la semana pasada: el cambio es difícil, pero también es una señal de que Dios está con nosotros y de que Dios está obrando.

Me gustaría aprovechar este momento para pedir a todos que den las gracias a los miembros de la Junta de la Academia, tanto a los actuales como a los anteriores. Aman a nuestros jóvenes y han trabajado muy duro para asegurarse de que la escuela tuviera todo lo necesario para mantener un alto nivel, buenas calificaciones y el testimonio y los valores católicos. También quiero dar las gracias, en su nombre, a todos los directores de la escuela, tanto los anteriores como los actuales, incluidas las hermanas de Santo Domingo que han enseñado en nuestra escuela durante generaciones. Quiero dar las gracias a nuestros profesores, auxiliares y personal de apoyo, que dan tanto de sí mismos porque aman a nuestros hijos. Quiero dar las gracias a todos los padres y familias que se han sacrificado tanto para que sus hijos recibieran una excelente educación católica. Por último, quiero dar las gracias a los alumnos y a nuestros antiguos alumnos. Este cierre ha sido más duro para ellos, ya que muchos de los alumnos actuales pasarán a diferentes colegios católicos y no católicos.

Todos ustedes están en el Sagrado Corazón de Jesús en este mes de junio, dedicado al Sagrado Corazón. Aunque la escuela va a cerrar, la educación católica y la labor de formar a nuestros hijos continúan. Como dije la semana pasada, esta labor prosigue a través de nuestra educación religiosa —que es aún más importante— y de los programas para los jóvenes de la parroquia. Estos programas deben adaptarse a esta nueva realidad y ahora debemos redoblar nuestro apoyo y nuestro esfuerzo en estos ámbitos. Seguimos teniendo que educar a nuestros hijos. Nuestro sistema de educación de la escuela católica parroquial continuará al vincularnos con la Academia San Gregorio Magno. Se ha invitado a la Junta de la Academia a formar parte de su consejo. La escuela ha igualado nuestra matrícula, los alumnos con becas seguirán contándolas, la Beca San Carlo continúa, y se nos pedirá que apoyemos a nuestros hijos en esa academia. El padre Mamuel y yo formaremos parte de su junta, y se invitará a nuestros alumnos de Educación Religiosa a discernir si desean asistir a esa Academia. Esto es similar a lo que ocurrió cuando San Gerardo cerró su escuela hace 20 años. Y aunque aquello fue triste y difícil, todo ha resultado ser una bendición y una gracia. ¡Dios obró con nosotros en aquel momento de cambio y Dios está obrando ahora! Por último, aunque me mudaré a finales de mes, el obispo Brennan me ha pedido que siga como presidente de la junta directiva. Firmaré todos los cheques, pagaré todas las facturas pendientes, organizaré el material de las aulas para trasladarlo a San Gregorio y, más adelante, a la Inmaculada Concepción y a las demás academias del decanato. Trabajaré con el padre Samuel en todo esto durante el verano y el otoño, así que es posible que me vean por la Encarnación de vez en cuando. Sandra, secretaria de la Academia, pasará a formar parte del equipo de la parroquia, donde trabajará como empleada, y seguirá siendo feligresa. Denise, aunque se trasladará conmigo para trabajar en Nuestra Señora de Lourdes como asistente administrativa del párroco y contable —actualmente la parroquia no cuenta con uno—, seguirá trabajando con la contabilidad de la Academia en QuickBooks y, por supuesto, sigue siendo una feligresa activa de la parroquia de la Encarnación-San Gerardo. La empresa de limpieza de la Academia seguirá trabajando durante el Verano para ayudarme a organizarlo todo, y todos los expedientes de la Academia se entregarán a cada alumno actual o se empaquetarán y enviarán a los Archivos de la Diócesis para su archivo. Si necesita su expediente, tendrá que ponerse en contacto con ellos. El edificio en sí, por supuesto, seguirá siendo utilizado por la parroquia. La comunidad, junto con el Padre Samuel, los administradores de la parroquia, el nuevo consejo de finanzas parroquial y el nuevo consejo pastoral parroquial que él creará, y la oficina inmobiliaria de la diócesis, tendrán que discernir cómo se utilizará el edificio para generar fondos para la parroquia. Esto se hará finalmente mediante un contrato de arrendamiento a largo plazo, similar al del alquiler de San Gerardo.

Esto requerirá tiempo, discernimiento, paciencia y oración. La posibilidad de alquilar parte o la totalidad del edificio ayudará a resolver de una vez por todas el problema de la deuda a largo plazo de la parroquia. Si alguien tiene alguna pregunta o inquietud sobre todo esto, por favor, póngase en contacto conmigo ahora, o cuando me mude a Lourdes.

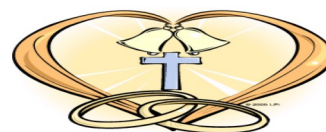

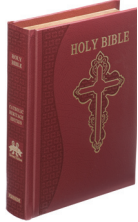
