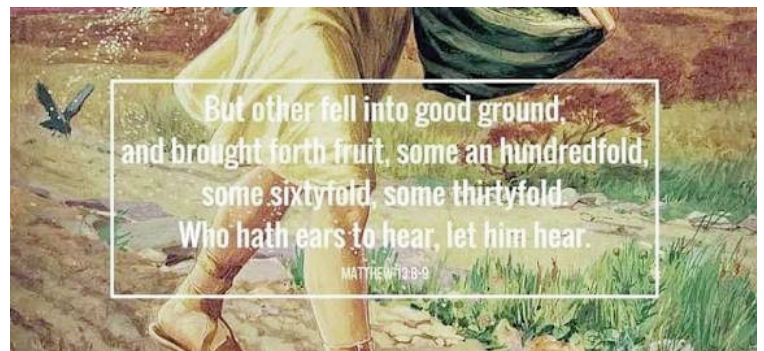

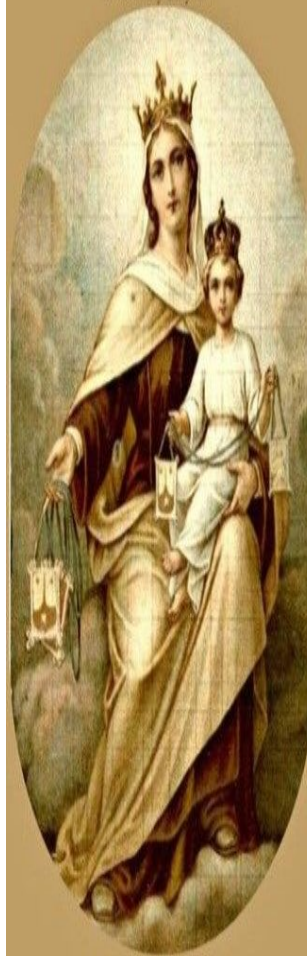

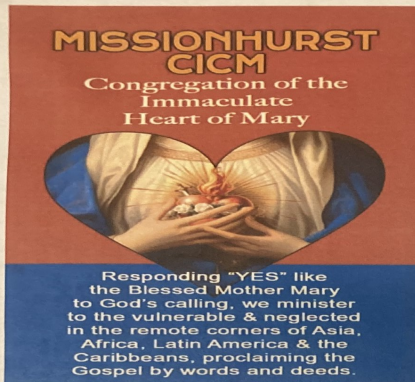

Why? Because most people we serve live in remote, abandoned & neglected communities, celebrating the Eucharist in the open outside or under a tree.

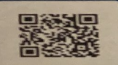
Many children are malnourished & don't go to school, either because one does not exist in their region or it's many miles away. Lack of education exposes them to human traffickers & gang ideologies.

Missionhurst-CICM

(Congregatio Immaculati Cordis Mariae)

Missionhurst-CICM was founded in 1862 by a Belgian priest, Fr. Theophile Verbist, initially for the evangelization of China.

Inspired by Father Verbist's example, Missionhurst priests and brothers have been first to proclaim the Good News in places where the Gospel is not preached or lived, with a particular emphasis on the care of the poor and the most vulnerable.

Today, Missionhurst-CICM missionary priests and brothers continue this long tradition of caring for God's poorest and most neglected in many parts of the world. CICM missionaries are prepared to stay, live among the people, share in their privation, and participate in the day-to-day effort needed to achieve life-long spiritual and material changes.

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

In our journey of faith, we often find ourselves in seasons that feel uncertain, heavy, or even painful. Like the people of Israel in exile, we may wonder if God's promises will truly come to pass. Yet the words of the prophet Isaiah remind us with great tenderness that God's word is never empty. Just as the rain and snow water the earth and make it fruitful, so too does God's word work quietly but powerfully in our lives, accomplishing His divine purpose in ways we may not immediately see.

St. Paul also speaks to the reality of our struggles. He reminds us that, like seeds that must fall to the ground and die in order to bear fruit, the sufferings we experience are not in vain. God uses even our pain to bring about redemption, growth, and new life within us. Though the waiting can be difficult, we are called to persevere with hope, trusting that an eternal reward awaits those who remain faithful.

In today's Gospel, we are invited to reflect on the condition of our own hearts. The word of God is constantly being sown into our lives, but its fruitfulness depends on how we receive it. Are our hearts open, receptive, and ready? Or are they hardened, distracted, or crowded with the worries of life?

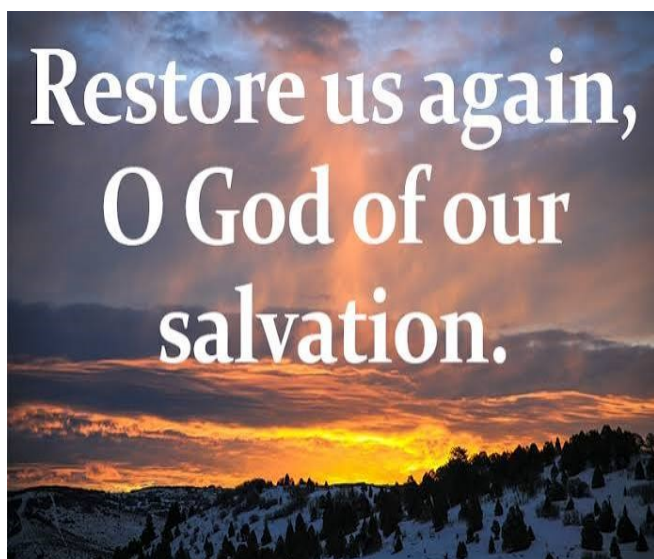
My dear friends, let us take this opportunity to prepare the soil of our hearts. Let us remove whatever hinders God's word from taking root—fear, doubt, resentment, or indifference—and instead, cultivate faith, trust, and openness. When we do this, God's word will not only grow within us but will bear fruit beyond all expectation—thirty, sixty, even a hundredfold.

Be encouraged: God is at work in you, even now. Every prayer, every act of love, every sacrifice made in faith is a seed planted in His kingdom. Do not grow weary. Continue to sow goodness, to trust in His promises, and to walk faithfully with the Lord.

In time, you will see the harvest.

May God bless you and strengthen you always.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

En nuestro camino de fe, a menudo nos encontramos en etapas que se perciben inciertas, pesadas o incluso dolorosas. Al igual que el pueblo de Israel en el exilio, podemos preguntarnos si las promesas de Dios realmente se cumplirán. Sin embargo, las palabras del profeta Isaías nos recuerdan con gran ternura que la palabra de Dios nunca vuelve vacía. Así como la lluvia y la nieve riegan la tierra y la hacen fecunda, la palabra de Dios obra silenciosa pero poderosamente en nuestras vidas, cumpliendo su propósito divino de maneras que tal vez no veamos de inmediato.

San Pablo también se refiere a la realidad de nuestras luchas. Nos recuerda que, al igual que las semillas que deben caer en tierra y morir para dar fruto, los sufrimientos que experimentamos no son en vano. Dios utiliza incluso nuestro dolor para obrar la redención, el crecimiento y una vida nueva en nosotros. Aunque la espera pueda resultar difícil, estamos llamados a perseverar con esperanza, confiando en que una recompensa eterna aguarda a quienes permanecen fieles.

En el Evangelio de hoy, se nos invita a reflexionar sobre el estado de nuestros propios corazones. La palabra de Dios se siembra constantemente en nuestras vidas, pero su fecundidad depende de cómo la recibimos. ¿Están nuestros corazones abiertos, receptivos y preparados? ¿O están endurecidos, distraídos o saturados por las preocupaciones de la vida?

Queridos amigos, aprovechemos esta oportunidad para preparar la tierra de nuestros corazones. Eliminemos todo aquello que impida que la palabra de Dios eche raíces —el miedo, la duda, el resentimiento o la indiferencia— y cultivemos, en cambio, la fe, la confianza y la apertura. Cuando lo hacemos, la palabra de Dios no solo crece en nosotros, sino que da fruto más allá de toda expectativa: al treinta, al sesenta y hasta al ciento por uno.

Ánimo: Dios está obrando en ustedes, incluso ahora. Cada oración, cada acto de amor, cada sacrificio hecho con fe es una semilla plantada en su Reino. No se cansen. Sigán sembrando el bien, confiando en sus promesas y caminando fielmente con el Señor. A su debido tiempo, verán la cosecha.

Que Dios los bendiga y los fortalezca siempre.

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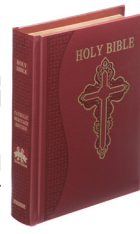
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
